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# CORPORATE PROFILE

## Introduction

**Tarzan Enterprise Ltd. is a wholly owned Ghanaian family business, founded in 1942 as a road transport company, then later diversifying into warehousing, logistics, asset management and general trade.**



In its early days, the company gained its regional reputation for transporting Ghanaians pilgrims who wanted to perform Hajj in Saudi Arabia, between 1945 and 1955, when its founder, the late H.M.K. Hamoui used to lead the road convoy himself, during the six-month journey from Accra and back, to Jeddah and across the Red Sea through Port Sudan.

It then got the honor of carrying the ballot boxes of the first-ever Ghanaian elections, when the country declared its independence from British colonialism.

In the early 1970s, the company was crucial in alleviating the huge

congestion of the Nigerian ports, when goods were landed in Ghana and transported into Nigeria by road.

Then, in the early 80s, Tarzan trucks were active in the distribution of food relief in Ghana, in collaboration with USAID and the Adventist Development and Relief Agency (ADRA).

Today, Tarzan Enterprise Ltd. has grown into a conglomerate which includes warehousing, container handling, commercial stores and general trade, taking pride in its long history and its goodwill, based on years of hard work and its reputation as a reliable business partner in Ghana.

## Cocoa Logistics



The company’s entrance into the cocoa value chain came in 1979, when it received its call to serve the nation from the late Alhaji Mumuni Bawumia, who was the Chief Executive Officer of COCOBOD at the time, to help Ghana set up its budding cocoa industry, by providing logistics support services to move cocoa beans from the hinterland and assist with its export operations from the country’s ports in Tema and Takoradi. Tarzan Enterprise Ltd. liquidated most of its regional operations in Nigeria and elsewhere, in order to reconsolidate its activity in Ghana and help the cocoa industry to thrive into what it is today: a global powerhouse in cocoa export.



Tarzan Enterprise Ltd. continues to deliver the highest quality of integrated logistics services to the cocoa industry: warehousing facilities, road transportation and container handling. The company is proud of its association with COCOBOD and the cocoa industry in Ghana, where it is considered by many as a stabilizing factor to the logistics support operations of this vital pillar of Ghanaian economy.

### “Certificate of Honor”

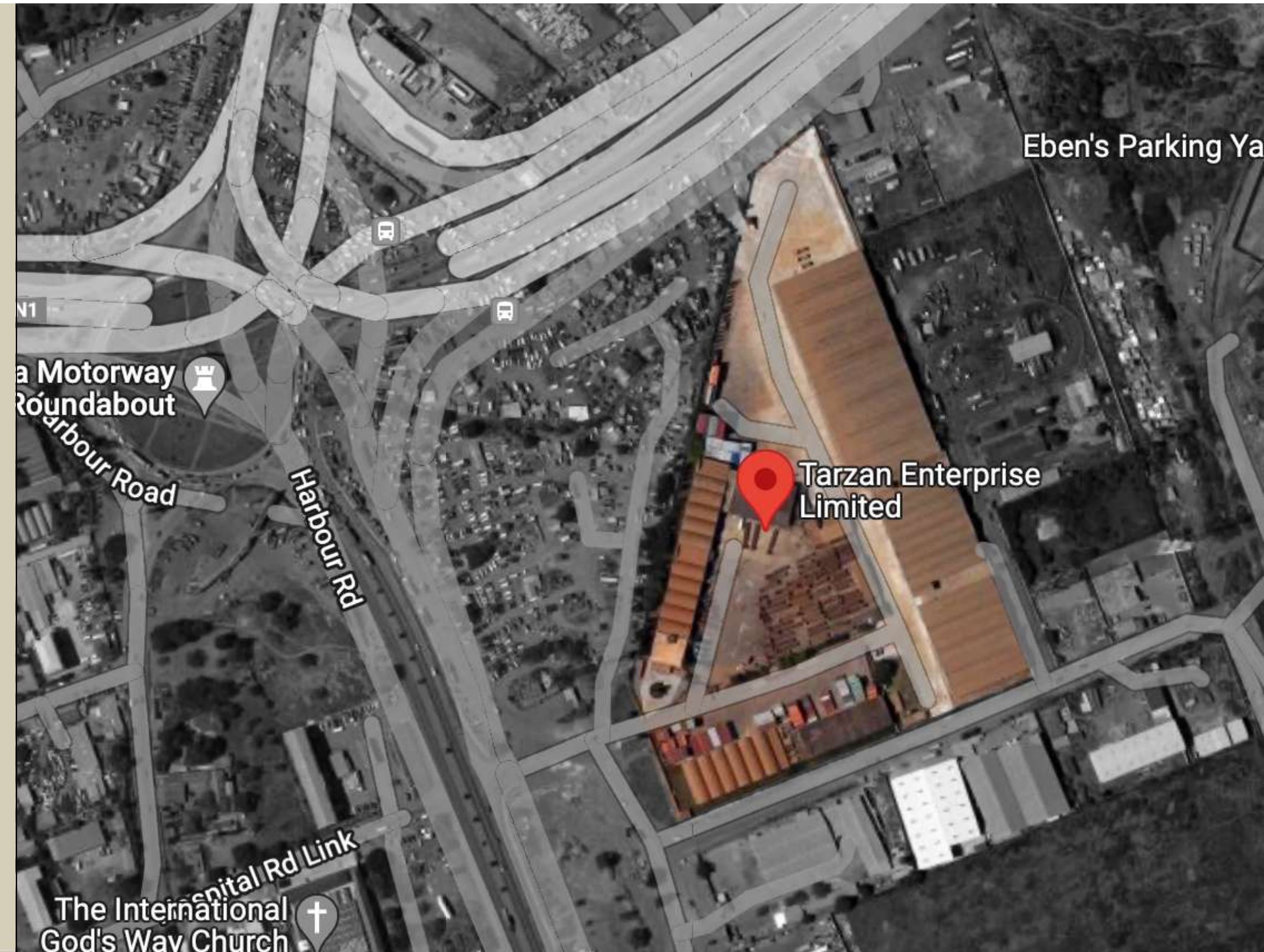
